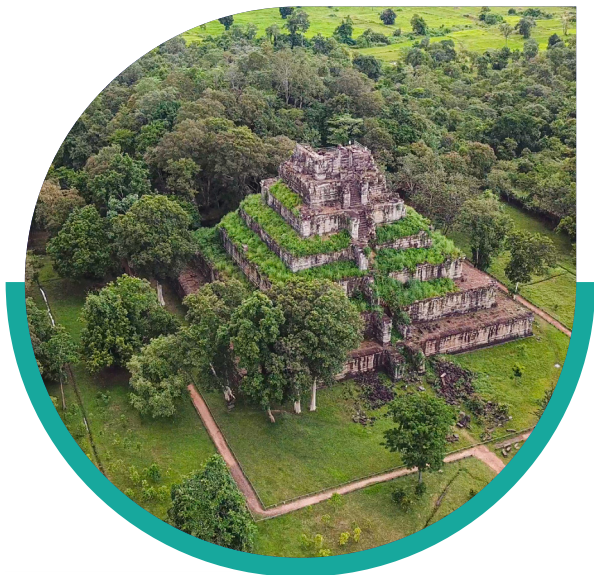

Festival & National Religious Holiday – Across Cambodia - October 10 to 12

Tip for Travelers: Marking the coronation of His Majesty King Norodom Sihamoni in 2004, this day is observed with royal ceremonies, religious blessings, and tributes to the monarchy. While celebrations are generally formal and reserved, visitors in Phnom Penh can witness official events near the Royal Palace, including traditional music and flag displays.

COMMEMORATION OF THE LATE KING FATHER

National Holiday – Phnom Penh - October 15

Tip for Travelers: This day commemorates the UNESCO inscription of Lkhon Khol of Wat Svay Andet, Cambodia's traditional masked theatre, on November 28, 2018—an art deeply rooted in the Reamker epic.



ANNIVERSARY OF KUN LBOKATOR LISTED IN UNESCO INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE AND HUMANITY

Commemorative Day - November 29

Tip for Travelers: This date marks the official inscription of Kun Lbokator, the ancient Khmer martial art, on UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in November 2022.



ANNIVERSARY OF CHAPEI DANG VENG LISTED IN UNESCO INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE AND HUMANITY

Commemorative Day - November 30

Tip for Travelers: This date commemorates the inscription of Chapei Dang Veng, Cambodia's traditional storytelling lute music, onto UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage in Need of Urgent Safeguarding on November 30, 2016.

ANNIVERSARY OF TUG OF WAR LISTED IN UNESCO INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE AND HUMANITY Commemorative Day - December 2

Tip for Travelers: This date marks the UNESCO inscription of Tugging Rituals and Games—Cambodia’s traditional Lbaeng Teanb Prot on December 2, 2015.



ANNIVERSARY OF KRAMA KHMER (KHMER SCARF) LISTED IN UNESCO INTANGIBLE CULTURAL HERITAGE AND HUMANITY Commemorative Day - December 4

Tip for Travelers: This day marks the UNESCO recognition of Krama, Cambodia’s iconic checkered scarf, inscribed on the Representative List of Intangible Cultural Heritage in 2024. Visit public markets like Central Market or Toul Tompong (Russian Market) in Phnom Penh for a wide selection—cotton and silk types available.



SEA FESTIVAL Major Coastal Tourism Festival – Annual-Event - Koh Kong 2 to 14 December (TBC)

Tip for Travelers: Celebrate Cambodia’s vibrant coastline at the annual Sea Festival, rotating between Kep, Kampot, Koh Kong, and Sihanoukville. Expect thrilling beach sports, cultural shows, concerts, fireworks, and local food fairs.



ANGKOR INTERNATIONAL HALF MARATHON Annual International Sport Event – Siem Reap - December 6 (TBC)

Tip for Travelers: Join tens of thousands of participants from around the world for an unforgettable run through ancient temples and forested paths. This iconic race supports meaningful causes, including child healthcare and vital community programs.
